Dear Parents/Guardians,

Semester 1, Term 2 is coming to an end. We would like to take this opportunity to inform you of upcoming events/activities that will be happening in the month of May. Please do visit our school website, www.horizonpri.moe.edu.sg to keep yourselves updated on the latest news and events.

1. Public Holidays

Labour Day and Vesak Day fall on Monday, 1 May 2017 and Wednesday, 10 May 2017 respectively. We wish all our Buddhist students and their parents a very special Vesak Day.

2. P1 to P6 Home-Based Learning Exercise on Friday 19 May 2017

E-learning is part of the teaching and learning strategies used in Horizon Primary School. The school's e-learning portal enables students to enrich and enhance their knowledge in English Language, Mathematics, Science and Mother Tongue Languages through the use of ICT.

To ensure continuity of learning during School Admin Day on Friday, 19 May 2017, the school will be conducting a Home-Based Learning (HBL) Exercise. We hope that through this exercise, students will develop self-directed learning skills that will enable them to be independent learners. At the same time, it ensures that our students are well prepared in the event that they are required to learn from home.

English, Mathematics, Science and Malay Language assignments will be carried out through www.mconline.sg while Chinese Language assignments will be carried out on www.ezhishi.net and Tamil Language assignments on www.pazhahutamil.com.

For students with no computer or internet access at home, parents are strongly encouraged to find alternative venues for their children to access the LMS on that day.

Students are advised to access their LMS accounts prior to the HBL exercise to ensure that they do not face difficulties when gaining access to the portal on that day. If they do encounter problems, please do let your child's/ward's Form Teacher know. We will provide the necessary support for your child's/ward's HBL.

4. P4 Briefing on Subject-based Banding (SBB) on Wednesday 24 May 2017

The school will be conducting a briefing session to share with parents and guardians about matters relating to Subject-based banding (SBB) on Wednesday, 24 May 2017 from 4.30 p.m. to 5.30 p.m.. SBB caters to the strengths of students and inspires them to achieve greater heights. The information shared during this session will help you in selecting the best option that suits your child's / ward's learning needs. We look forward to meeting you.

5. P4 and P6 NAPFA Test

The National Physical Fitness Award (NAPFA) test is a mandatory nationwide assessment for Primary 4 and Primary 6 students to measure and evaluate the different components of health and skills related fitness.

The NAPFA test consists of 6 stations:

- i. Station 1: Sit-ups
- ii. Station 2: Standing Broad Jump
- iii. Station 3: Sit & Reach
- iv. Station 4: Inclined Pull-ups
- v. Station 5: Shuttle Run
- vi. Station 6: 1.6km run/walk

Primary 4 and Primary 6 students will be taking the test in Week 8 and 9. A separate letter has been issued to all parents of Primary 4 and Primary 6 students dated 26 April 2017.

6. P6 Meet-the-Parents Session (2) on Thursday 25 May 2017 and Friday 26 May 2017

The school will be organising its Meet-The-Parent Session (2) for Primary 6 students on Thursday, 25 May 2017 and Friday, 26 May 2017, from 2.30 p.m. to 6.00 p.m. The objective of the session is to provide a platform for the parents and guardians of Primary 6 students to engage in conversations with their child's/ward's class teachers about his/her progress in learning. Thank you parents for working together with us in supporting your child through his/her learning journey in Horizon!

7. P6 Booster Programme (I) from 19 to 23 June 2017

The school will be organising the above programme to support our Primary 6 students in their preparations for the assessments in Semester 2 with the Primary School Leaving Examinations (PSLE) being the 'End in Mind'. The students will go through a **1 day of 'I-LEAD I-MOTIVATE' Workshop** and **4 days of Booster Teaching sessions** during the week. Details of the above programme will be given to the Primary 6 students in a separate letter.

8. Health-related Measures for Term 2 School Holidays and Temperature Taking Exercise for Term 3 Week 1

The term 2 school holidays begin from Saturday 27 May 2017 and students will return to school on Tuesday, 27 June 2017 as Monday, 26 June 2017 is a public holiday. All Primary 1 students will be issued with a hardcopy Travel Declaration Form in the third week of May for submission to the Form Teacher. A "Nil" return is required. Primary 2 to 6 students will download the Travel Declaration Form from the school website and submit to their Form Teachers only if they are travelling. All Travel Declaration Forms must be submitted by Wednesday, 24 May 2017.

When travelling to flu-risk countries, please be reminded to avoid crowded areas and maintain high standards of personal hygiene at all times. We would like all parents to continue to exercise social responsibility. If your child is unwell during or after the school holidays, please bring him/her to see a doctor immediately and allow them to rest at home till they have recovered. We seek your cooperation so that we can prevent the possible spread of contagious disease among the staff and students after their return from school holidays.

The school will be conducting a Temperature Taking Exercise on Thursday, 29 June in the first week after the school holidays.

9. School Tour to Horizon Primary School for Parents of K2 Students

The school will be conducting a school tour on Friday, 30 June 2017 for parents of children who are born in the year 2011 and due for P1 Registration this year. Online registration for the school tour will be available from Friday, 12 May 2017 to Monday, 19 June, 2017. Along the line of Horizon Primary School's strong belief in collaboration with the community, the school will be hosting K2 students from selected pre-schools in Punggol area in the month of July to allow them to have an experience in a primary school setting.
