Dear Parents/Guardians,

Term 2 is coming to an end. We would like to take this opportunity to inform you of upcoming events/activities that will be happening in the month of May. **1. Public Holidays**

Labour Day and Vesak Day fall on Tuesday, 1 May 2018, and Tuesday, 29 May 2018, respectively. We wish all our Buddhist students and their parents a very special Vesak Day.

**2. P1 to P6 Home-Based Learning Exercise on Monday, 21 May 2018**

E-learning is part of the teaching and learning strategies used in Horizon Primary School. The school's e-learning portal enables students to enrich and enhance their knowledge in the various subjects through the use of ICT.

To ensure continuity of learning during School Admin Day on Monday, 21 May 2018, the school will be conducting a Home-Based Learning (HBL) Exercise. Through this exercise, students will develop self-directed learning skills that will enable them to be independent learners. At the same time, it ensures that our students are well prepared in the event that they are required to learn from home.

English, Science and Malay Language assignments will be carried out through [www.mconline.sg](http://www.mconline.sg) while Chinese Language assignments will be carried out on [www.ezhishi.net](http://www.ezhishi.net) and Tamil Language assignments on [www.pazhahutamil.com](http://www.pazhahutamil.com). Mathematics assignments will be carried out on <https://problemsums.koobits.com/>.

For students with no computer or internet access at home, parents are strongly encouraged to find alternative venues for their children to access the LMS on that day.

Students are advised to access their LMS accounts prior to the HBL exercise to ensure that they do not face difficulties when gaining access to the portal on that day. If they do encounter problems, please do let your child's/ward's Form Teacher know. We will provide the necessary support for your child's/ward's HBL.

**5. Singapore Student Learning Space (SLS)**

As part of our commitment to nurturing future-ready learners, the Ministry of Education had announced that all students in Singapore schools will be supported in their learning by the Singapore Student Learning Space (SLS), an online learning platform that contains curriculum-aligned resources and learning tools.

With the SLS, students will be able to learn better through the use of technology. Students will be able to learn anytime, anywhere, and at their own pace, whether independently or with their peers. Teachers will also be able to use the SLS to complement their classroom teaching, further enriching students' learning experience. This is in alignment with the school's belief in providing students with quality ICT-enriched learning experiences to ensure that students develop as responsible and effective users of ICT.

SLS is being rolled out to all schools in phases. The students in our school will be given their accounts from April 2018 onwards. Our ICT Support Team will guide your child/ward in activating the SLS account and using the learning platform in school. Subsequently, we will issue parents the details of your child's/ward's SLS account by **Tuesday, 22 May 2018**, once all students have completed the activation of accounts in school.

We look forward to your support as we help our students strengthen their learning through the SLS.

**6. P6 Booster Programme (I) from Monday, 18 June 2018, to Friday, 22 June 2018**

The school will be organising the above programme to support our Primary 6 students in their preparations for the assessments in Semester 2 for their Primary School Leaving Examinations (PSLE). The students will go through a **1-day 'I-LEAD I-MOTIVATE' Workshop** and **4 days of Booster Teaching sessions** during the week. Information will be sent via SNAC at a later date.

**7. Health-related Measures for Term 2 School Holidays and Temperature Taking Exercise for Term 3 Week 1**

Term 2 school holidays begin from Saturday, 26 May 2018, and students will return to school on Monday, 25 June 2018. All Primary 1 students will be issued with a hardcopy Travel Declaration Form in the third week of May for submission to the Form Teacher. A "Nil" return is required. Primary 2 to 6 students will download the Travel Declaration Form from the school website and submit it to their Form Teachers only if they are travelling. All Travel Declaration Forms must be submitted by **Tuesday, 22 May 2018**.

When travelling to flu-risk countries, please be reminded to avoid crowded areas and maintain high standards of personal hygiene at all times. We would like all parents to continue to exercise social responsibility. If your child/ward is unwell during or after the school holidays, please take him/her to see a doctor immediately and allow him/her to rest at home till he/she has recovered. We seek your cooperation so that we can prevent the possible spread of contagious disease among the staff and students after their return from school holidays.

**The school will be conducting a Temperature Taking Exercise on Thursday, 28 June 2018, in the first week after the school holidays.**

**8. Horizon Family Day and Parents' Tour on Friday, 13 July 2018**

This year, Horizon Family Day and Parents' Tour is jointly organised by the Parents-Connect! Committee and Horizon Primary School on Friday, 13 July 2018 from 10.30 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. Concurrently, prospective parents will be invited to join us for a school tour.

On that day, it will be an E-learning Day for all students. All students are to be proactive in completing their online assignments before attending Horizon Family Day to ensure continuity in their learning.

More details regarding Horizon Family Day will be released on our school website and Horizon parents and guardians will be required to register for the event via SNAC at a later date.
