Dear Parents/Guardians,

## 1. <u>Commencement of E2K, Small-Group Teaching (SGT) and P5 & P6 Supplementary Lessons</u>

Supplementary lessons for Primary 5 and 6 students will commence on Tuesday, 8 February 2022. Information has been sent out to parents via Parents Gateway (PG). Please note that supplementary lessons are compulsory for all Primary 5 and 6 students.

E2K (Mathematics & Science) for the Primary 4 and 5 and SGT for Primary 3 and 4 are for identified students only and they will commence on Thursday, 10 February 2022. If your child/ward has been selected for E2K and SGT, you will receive a letter from the school via Parents Gateway (PG) for your consent. We seek your support in ensuring that your child/ward attends these lessons that have been planned for them by the school.

#### 2. Cohort Engagement Sessions for Parents of Primary 1 and 3 Students

Cohort engagement sessions aim to allow parents to better understand the cohort programmes our students will be experiencing at the different levels. Details for the above engagement sessions have been sent to you via Parents Gateway (PG) last month and we are happy to receive your support for the upcoming sessions in February.
