Dear Parents / Guardians,

We would like to extend a warm welcome to all our students returning to school after the June school holidays. We start Term 3 with excitement and hope as we gradually resume many of our learning activities. In this letter, we would like to share with you the school events for the month of July.

1. School Holiday on Monday, 4 July 2022 in lieu of Youth Day

In lieu of Youth Day which falls on Sunday, 3 July 2022, the following day, **Monday, 4 July 2022,** will be a school holiday.

2. Primary 1 to 6 Class Photo-taking on Thursday, 7 July 2022 and Friday, 8 July 2022

All classes have been scheduled for their class photo-taking session on **Thursday**, **7 July 2022 and Friday 8 July 2022**. Form Teachers will inform their respective classes on the date and time for the photo-taking. All students are to be in their school uniform for their photo-taking session.

3. National Education (NE) Show for Primary 5 Students on Saturday, 9 July 2022

With the stabilisation of Covid-19 situation in Singapore, we are delighted and grateful that the National Education (NE) Show has been resumed and offered to our Primary 5 students this year. Through the participation in NE Show, we aim to evoke a sense of patriotism amongst students, instill in them the significance of National Day and develop a sense of belonging and commitment towards the nation and the community in them. We look forward to the NE show, where students celebrate Singapore's success with fellow Primary 5 students across Singapore. Details of the NE show will be shared with parents of P5 students nearer the date.

4. Public Holiday on Monday, 11 July 2022 in lieu of Hari Raya Haji

In lieu of Hari Raya Haji which falls on Sunday, 10 July 2022, the following day, **Monday, 11 July 2022**, will be a public holiday. We would like to wish all our Muslim staff, parents and students Selamat Hari Raya Haji.

5. Commemoration of Racial Harmony Day on Monday, 18 July 2022

As a school, we will be commemorating Racial Harmony Day on **Monday**, **18 July 2022**. The theme for this year is *Singapore: Our Multicultural Mosaic*. It focuses on the appreciation of the diverse races and religions that make up our multicultural society, which contribute to our shared sense of cohesion and harmony. All students and staff are encouraged to dress in traditional costumes with school shoes on 18 July 2022, as we come together to celebrate our unity as a community of different cultural backgrounds.

6. Aesthetic Week, 25 July 2022 to Friday 29 July 2022

Our Aesthetics Week aims to develop the students' strengths and interests by giving them opportunities to experience and experiment with art forms during the P1 and P2 Viva la Musica and P6 Art Exhibition. Our students get to showcase their artworks and musical performances. These platforms also allow our performers and student leaders to exercise their leadership skills and improve on their life skills, i.e. relationship management and confidence building. Student audiences get to learn museum and concert etiquettes and be inspired by their peers.



Every year, during Viva la Musica, our Primary 1 and 2 students showcase their creative expression and communication through music and art making. The students are also able to heighten their awareness and appreciation for the Arts. Viva la Musica helps students to develop an informed and lifelong involvement in the Arts. The Primary 1 Viva la Musica will be held in school on **Tuesday**, **26 July 2022** and the P2 Viva la Musica will be held in school on **Thursday**, **28 July 2022**.

The Primary 6 Art Exhibition themed 'Identity' is a platform to showcase our Primary 6 students' creative artworks done during last Semester to express their ideas and it will be held in school from **Wednesday**, **20 July 2022 to Friday**, **12 August 2022**. All P1- P5 classes will be scheduled to visit the on-site art exhibition as part of their learning in the art curriculum. The Primary 6 Art Exhibition also aims to integrate our school art curriculum with our in-house exhibition. Our students from P1- P6 will be able to view all the artworks and participate in art activities.

7. Early Dismissal for Primary 6 Preliminary Oral Examination days on Wednesday, 27 July 2022 and Thursday, 28 July 2022

The Primary 6 Preliminary Oral Examination will be conducted on **Wednesday**, **27 July 2022** and **Thursday**, **28 July 2022**. In view of this event, **Primary 1 to 5 students will be dismissed at 12.45 p.m.** on these two days.

Details will be given out to parents of Primary 6 students nearer to the dates of the oral examinations. Please take note of the following guidelines, as stated in the <u>Assessment Information 2022</u> given out in the beginning of the year, to ensure understanding and smooth administration of the school assessments.

- a. Students who are unable to take their oral examinations because of valid reasons (VR) will take both their English/Foundation English and Mother Tongue/Foundation Mother Tongue oral examinations on the following day of the oral examination.
- b. Students who have missed the make-up oral examination due to valid reasons will need to produce the medical certificate on the day of return to school. Students will be given a 'VR' status for the subject that they have missed. Students with no valid reasons will be awarded a "0" (i.e. zero mark) for the assessment.

8. National Day Celebrations and Horizon Family Day on Monday, 8 August 2022

We will be holding our National Day Celebrations and Horizon Family Day (NDC&HFD) 2022 on **Monday, 8 August 2022**. We believe that celebrating our annual Horizon Family Day jointly with National Day is apt as it demonstrates our aspiration to build our Horizon family spirit. This goes well in line with this year's National Day theme of *Stronger Together, Majulah!*, which is a call for all Singaporeans to forge ahead as a united and strong people towards a better future. *Stronger Together* reminds Singaporeans that unity in our diversity is what makes us stronger. This year, we have also invited onboard our community partners, Horizon RC and Breeze RN. We believe that the togetherness of our family and community unit is the bedrock of the solidarity of our nation.

NDC&HFD2022 is an event proudly brought to our Horizon community jointly by the school and our Parents Connect! team. NDC&HFD2022 will be held virtually as a series of activities of different nature (e.g. arts and physical activities) on 8 August 2022. There are also outdoor fringe activities which your family could partake in **between 6 - 14 August 2022**.
