We are looking forward to an exciting month filled with events and meaningful experiences for our students. Besides observing the nation's 57th birthday, we will also be celebrating our Horizon Family Day.

In this letter, we are delighted to share with you some updates and events planned for the month of August:

1. <u>National Day Celebration and Horizon Family Day 2022 on Monday, 8 August 2022</u>

Our virtual National Day Celebration and Horizon Family Day (NDC & HFD) 2022 is just around the corner! We would like to thank parents/guardians for the overwhelming support. On Monday, 8 August 2022, we invite all family members and students of Horizon Primary School to join us via our Zoom Webinar or Facebook Live from home.

As shared earlier, this year's NDC & HFD 2022 is particularly special given the strong alignment of the spirit of this event to this year's National Day theme of *Stronger Together, Majulah!* In addition, Ms Yeo Wan Ling, Advisor to Punggol Shore Grassroots Organisations and Member of Parliament for Pasir Ris – Punggol GRC, will be gracing the celebration. 2. National Day 2022 and Day After National Day 2022 on Tuesday, 9 August 2022 and Wednesday, 10 August 2022

Tuesday, 9 August 2022, is Singapore's 57th National Day while Wednesday, 10 August 2022, is the day after National Day. Students do not need to report to school on both days as the former is a public holiday while the latter is a scheduled school holiday.

3. Primary 6 PSLE Oral Examination on Monday, 15 August 2022 and Tuesday, 16 August 2022

The Primary 6 PSLE Oral Examination will be held on Monday, 15 August 2022, and Tuesday, 16 August 2022. Please note that Primary 1 to Primary 5 students will be engaged in Home-based Learning (HBL) on the above-mentioned two dates. Our teachers have worked hard together with our Primary 6 students to prepare them for the upcoming oral examination. We wish our Primary 6 students well as they sit for their first national examination.

Details of the examination will be provided to parents/guardians of Primary 6 students in a separate letter.



4. <u>Home-Based Learning (HBL) for Primary 1 to Primary 5 Students on Monday, 15 August 2022 and Tuesday, 16 August 2022</u>

The school will be conducting HBL on Monday, 15 August 2022, and Tuesday, 16 August 2022, to ensure continuity of learning during the PSLE Oral Examination. HBL develops students' dispositions and skills needed for self-directed learning.

English, Science and Malay Language assignments will be carried out through the Singapore Student Learning Space (SLS) on https://vle.learning.moe.edu.sg/login. Chinese Language assignments will be carried out on www.ezhishi.net, Tamil Language assignments will be carried out on https://pazhahutamil.sg and Mathematics assignments will be carried out on https://problemsums.koobits.com/.

Students are advised to access their online learning accounts prior to HBL to ensure that they do not face difficulties when gaining access to the portal on those days. If they do encounter problems, please inform your children's/wards' Form Teachers. We will provide the necessary support for your children's/wards' HBL.

The identification exercise is carried out for Primary 3 students in two stages – Screening and Selection. The Screening Stage will be held on Wednesday, 17 August 2022. Shortlisted students will be invited to the Selection Stage which will be held on Tuesday, 18 October 2022, and Wednesday, 19 October 2022.
