6. Primary 6 Post-PSLE Programme 2022

A spread of activities catered for the mind and body have been planned for our Primary 6 students as part of the post-PSLE Programme to continue to maximise their learning opportunities in Horizon Primary School.

For example, the students will be embarking on their final series of lessons in Computational Thinking in Mathematics (CTiM). This is our Applied Learning Programme (ALP) which provides opportunities for students to acquire information and technology literacies as well as develop students' 21st century skills and dispositions such as resilience and collaboration.

In addition, there will be a half-day workshop for all students on dealing with stressors and anxiety associated with transitions as they prepare to enter secondary school and manage other changes in their lives as teenagers. Students can also look forward to an interesting learning journey with their classmates - the *Race to Sustainability!* programme at Gardens by the Bay. More details on the learning journey will be shared closer to the actual date.
