Dear Parents/Guardians,

During the last week of Term 3, we celebrated Teachers' Day through a charity walk, Horizon Cares!. A total of 1,686 students and 126 staff members from the primary and kindergarten sections, together with 585 parents participated and we are proud to inform you that we have covered an impressive distance of 5 960.88 km! For every 300 m recorded, FairPrice Foundation will donate 1 bowl of white rice, 1 bowl of brown rice and 1 bowl of oatmeal to a vulnerable family residing in South-East District. Thankful to the synergy, our collective steps have translated into an incredible 19 870 sets for the needy! In celebration of the school's 15th anniversary, the event carried deeper meaning as it embodied the theme "Leading with Hearts, Serving with Purpose". What made this event particularly special was its integration into the Teachers' Day celebration, fostering a stronger sense of togetherness and community. We are into the final term of the 2024 school year. In this letter, we will share with you some updates and events planned for the month of October:

1. Change in Student Care Centre (SCC) and Kindergarten Care Centre (KCare) Vendor

With effect from 1 Jan 2025, Horizon Primary School will be partnering Nascans Pte Ltd as our new Student Care Centre (SCC) and Kindergarten Care Centre (KCare) vendor. Nascans Pte Ltd will be managing the transition in phases, starting with the current SCC and KCare students, followed by the incoming 2025 P1 / K1 students, before opening the registration to the remaining students. Nascans Pte Ltd will be contacting the identified students shortly to provide more details.

2. Celebrating EL Fiesta on Children's Day on Thursday, 3 October 2024

We will be celebrating our English Language (EL) Fiesta on <u>Thursday, 3 October 2024</u>, in conjunction with Children's Day celebrations this year. Through EL Fiesta, we hope to develop in our students a love for English Language and reading.

Students will report to school as per usual and the dismissal will be at <u>11.15am via the various dismissal points.</u> They can dress up as a character from the literature books or storybooks they have read.

To ensure the wellbeing of our students, we have factored in recess in their respective schedules. All students are encouraged to bring a small bag to keep their belongings and water bottles on that day. Looking forward to a fun-filled Children's Day Celebration! 3. Children's Day on Friday, 4 October 2024

4. <u>2024 PSLE Marking Days and Home-based Learning from Monday, 14 October 2024 to Wednesday, 16 October 2024</u>

All Primary 1 to Primary 6 students need not be in school from Monday, 14 October 2024 to Wednesday, 16 October 2024 as our teachers will be involved in the 2024 PSLE Marking Exercise. This year, Horizon Primary School has been designated as a PSLE Marking Centre. As such, students and parents are advised not to turn up in school on these days.

As shared earlier, Primary 1 to Primary 5 students will be assigned online or offline Home-Based Learning (HBL) tasks to facilitate their learning at home. For some classes, there will be 'LIVE' Zoom lessons scheduled for them either on Monday, 14 October 2024 (for P1 to P3) or Tuesday, 15 October 2024 (for P4 and P5) if their subject teachers are not deployed for PSLE marking duties. Please refer to the link shared below to check if your child/ward has scheduled 'LIVE' Zoom lessons. If the teacher is available, he/she would have indicated the timing of the Zoom lesson on the Activity/Assignment column. An empty slot would mean there is no Zoom lesson. Students would then practise Habit 1: Be Proactive and complete the assigned tasks by Wednesday, 16 October 2024. The learning activity/assignment in the schedule will be updated again in early October.

5. <u>2024 End-of-Year (EYE) Written Examinations from Friday, 18 October 2024 to Tuesday, 29 October 2024</u>

The EYE Written Examinations will be from Friday, 18 October 2024 to Tuesday, 29 October 2024. During this period, please ensure that your child/ward has sufficient sleep the night before and has a balanced meal. If he/she is unwell, please take him/her to see a doctor and let him/her rest at home. As shared in our Horizon Learning and Assessment plan, students



who are absent for any written paper must submit a valid medical certificate (MC) from a certified doctor upon their return to school. Letters by parent/guardian and will not be accepted.

There will not be any make-up assessment for students who are absent. He/she will attempt the assessment as a form of practice at the end of the assessment period. It will not be counted towards his/her overall results but serve as feedback on your child/ward's learning.

6. Primary 6 Post-PSLE Programme 2024

In line with Habit 7: Sharpen the Saw, a spread of activities catered for the mind and body have been planned for our Primary 6 students as part of the post-PSLE Programme to continue to maximise their learning opportunities in Horizon Primary School. For example, students will be engaged in lessons on Artificial Intelligence as part of our Computational Thinking in Mathematics (CTIM). This is our Applied Learning Programme (ALP) which provides opportunities for students to acquire information and technology literacies as well as develop students' 21st century skills and dispositions such as resilience and collaboration.

Moreover, a half-day workshop has been arranged for all students to address the challenges associated with stress and anxiety, especially in the context of transitioning to secondary school and managing the inevitable changes that accompany their teenage years.

Anticipating an exciting final out-of-school learning adventure with their peers, students will embark on the "Race to Sustainability!" programme at the Gardens by the Bay. More details about this educational journey will be shared closer to the scheduled date.
