3. <u>Home-Based Learning (HBL) for Primary 1 to Primary 5 Students during PSLE Marking Exercise from Monday, 14 October 2024 to Wednesday, 16 October 2024</u>

The school will be conducting HBL during the PSLE Marking Exercise for Primary 1 to Primary 5 students. This will take place from Monday, 14 October 2024 to Wednesday, 16 October 2024.

The HBL exercise aims to develop students' dispositions and skills needed for self-directed learning. As such, there will be synchronous and asynchronous learning activities for students. An example of synchronous learning is when students learn from a teacher in a virtual space via Zoom. An example of asynchronous learning refers to students accessing materials via SLS at their own pace. More details regarding the HBL exercise will be sent out in October.

4. <u>Gifted Education Screening Exercise for Primary 3 Students on Thursday, 15 August</u> 2024

The Ministry of Education is carrying out the identification of students for Gifted Education Programme (GEP) 2025. The identification exercise is carried out for Primary 3 students in two stages — Screening and Selection. The Screening Stage will be held on Thursday, 15 August 2024. Shortlisted students will be invited to the Selection Stage which will be held on Tuesday, 15 October 2024, and Wednesday, 16 October 2024.
