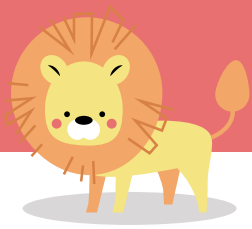
I know! Let's make a medal using recycled materials found at home!

MATERIALS



What materials do we need to make the medal?

Recycled materials found at home!

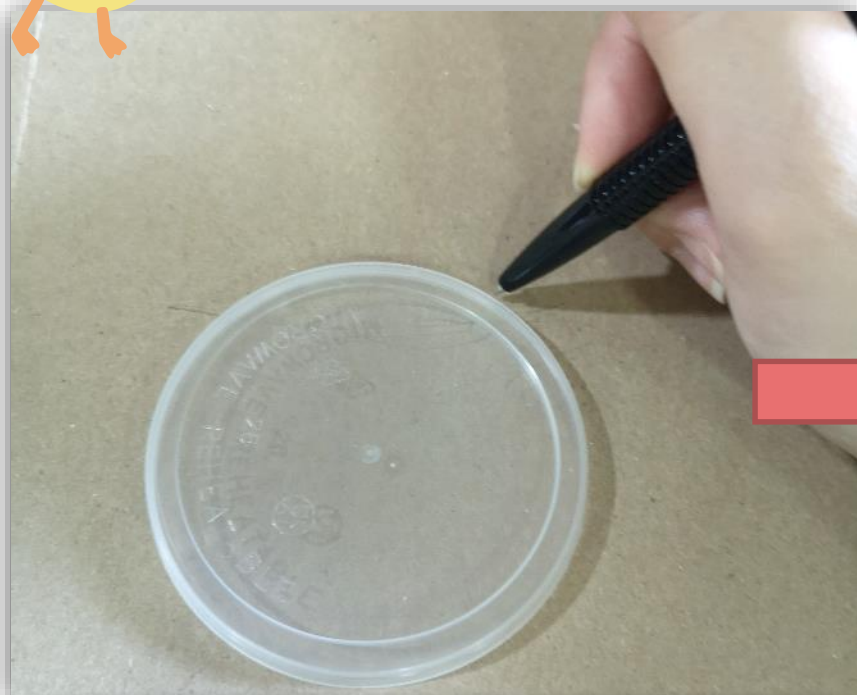


1. Cardboard material paper (You may cut out a small part from a cereal box)
2. Double-sided tape or scotch tape
3. Scissors
4. Colourful straws
5. Coloured markers
6. Pencil
7. Round container lid



Step 1

Making A Medal



Trace the circular outline of the lid using a pencil

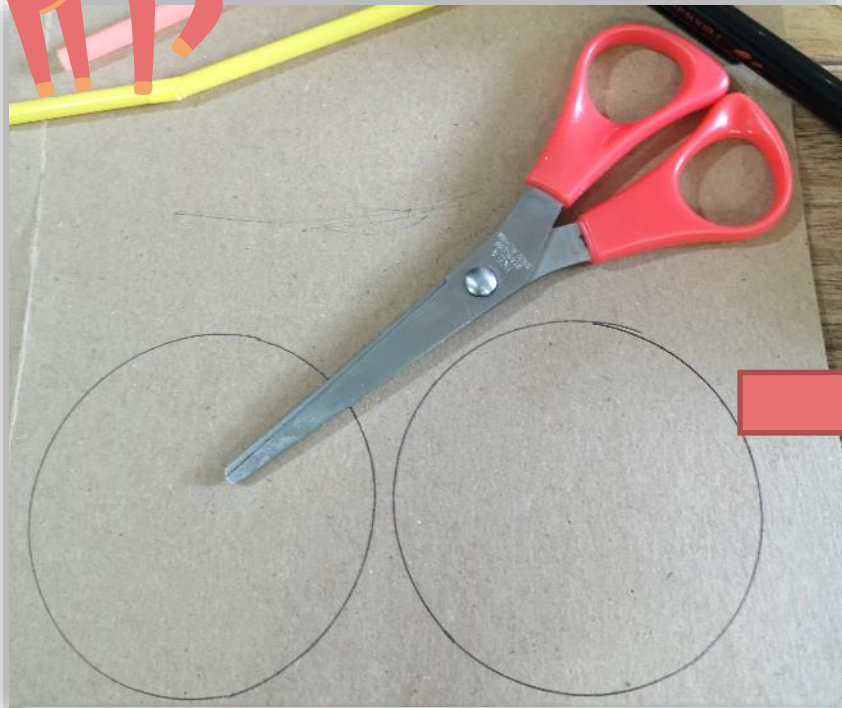


Draw 2 circles by tracing the lid using a pencil

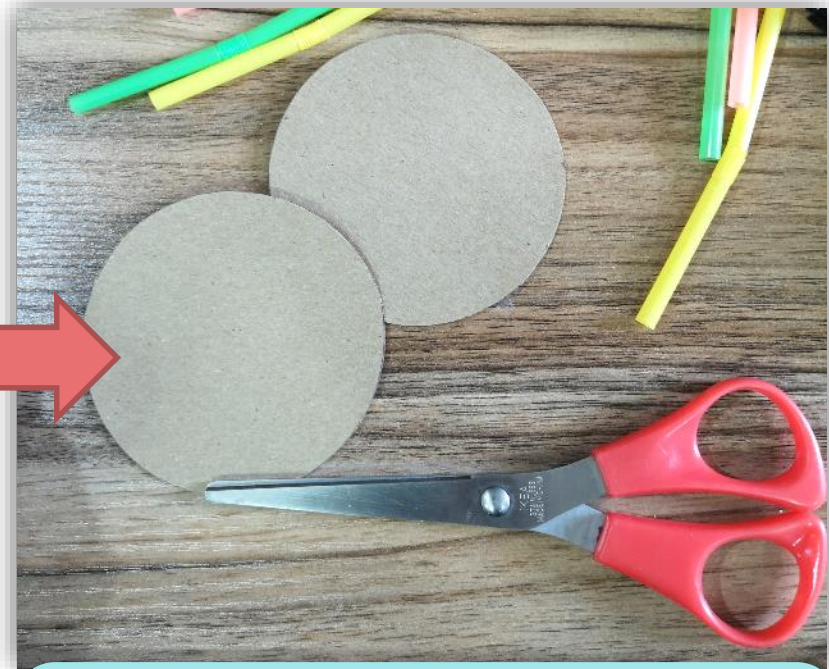


Step 2

Making A Medal



Cut the circles using a pair of scissors



2 circle cut-outs



Step 3

Making A Medal



Write 'Thank You, (Frontliner)' on one circle cut-out using coloured markers



Decorate using coloured markers



Step 4

Making A Medal



Write 'From: (Your Name)' on the 2nd circular cut-out



Decorate using coloured markers



Step 5

Making A Medal



Paste a double-sided tape behind a circle cut-out you have decorated



Stick both circle cut-outs together to form one circle



Step 6

Making A Medal



Poke a hole at the top, in the middle



Put a string through the hole

Step 7

Making A Medal



Cut the colourful straws into smaller bits



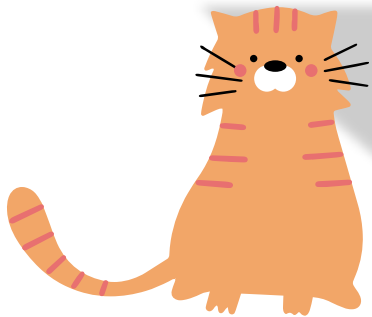
Put the straws through the string
