



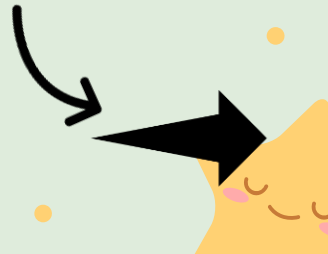

Any type of glue (glue stick/white glue) is fine.



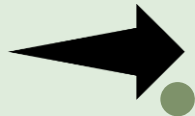
Recycled Materials

Any materials you can tear easily (Newspaper, magazines, brochures)

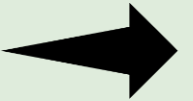


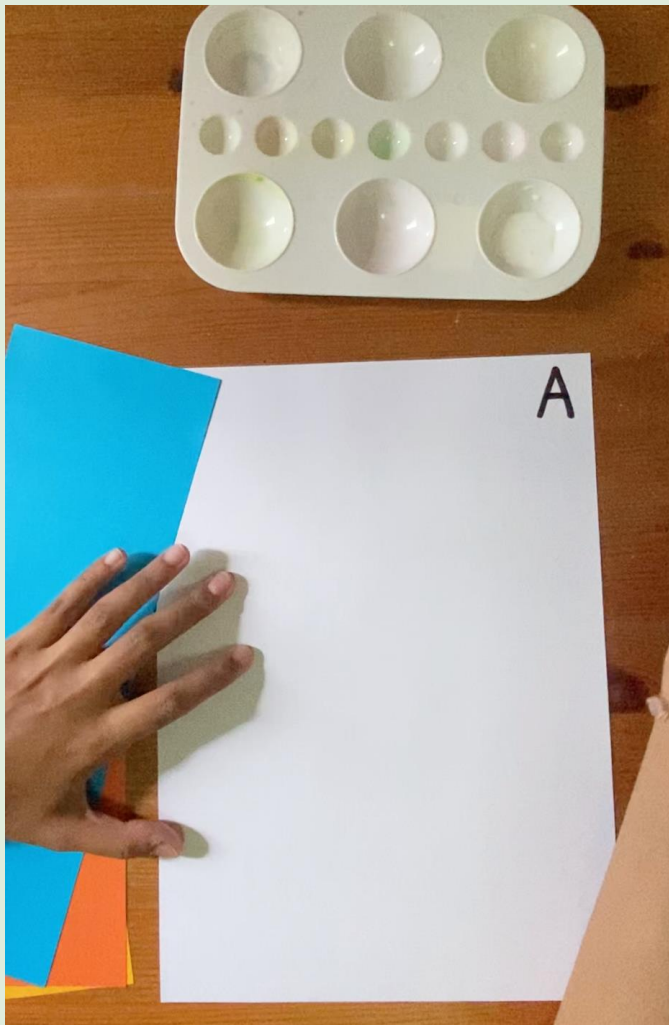
Writing Material

Step 1

What is the first letter of your name?

Aqida

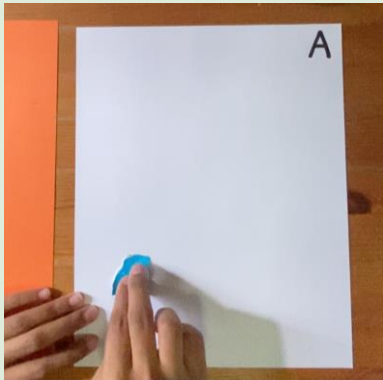
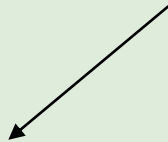
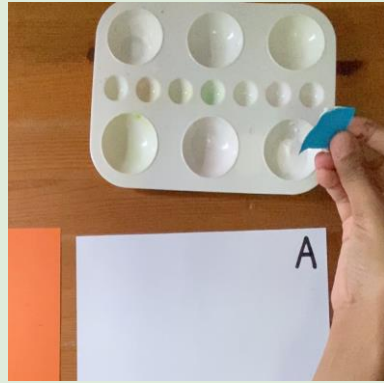
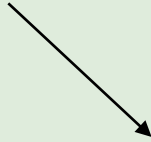
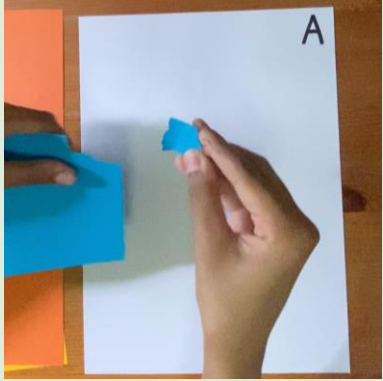
So, the first letter of my name is:

You can ask Mummy/Daddy to help you write it at the top, just like in the video.



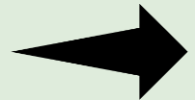
step 2

After the glue has dried, trace the letter you have created using your index finger.

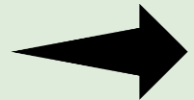
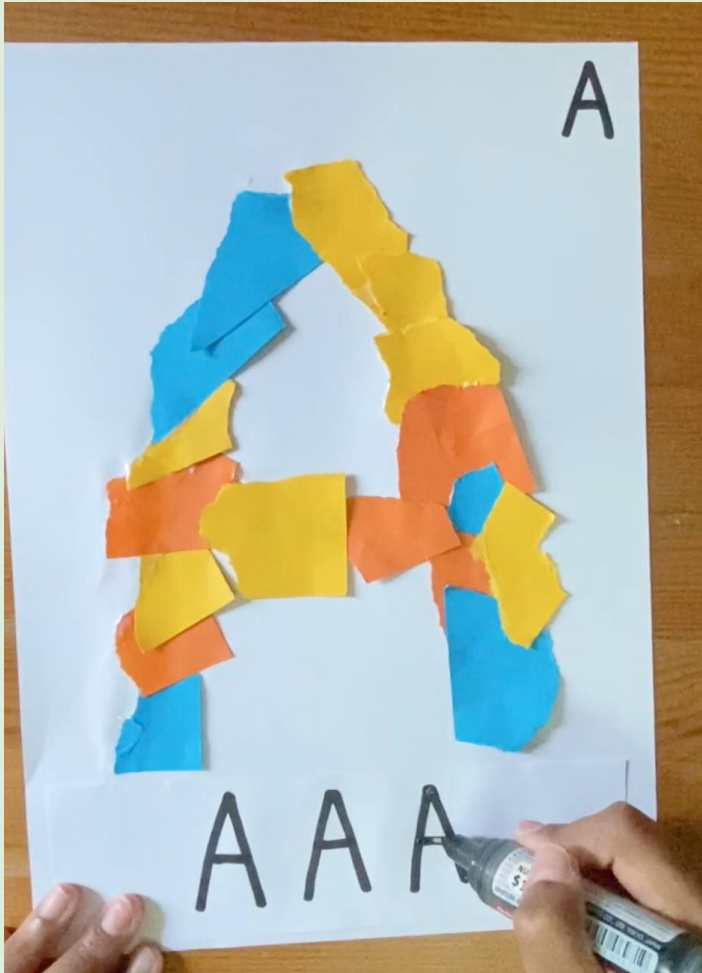


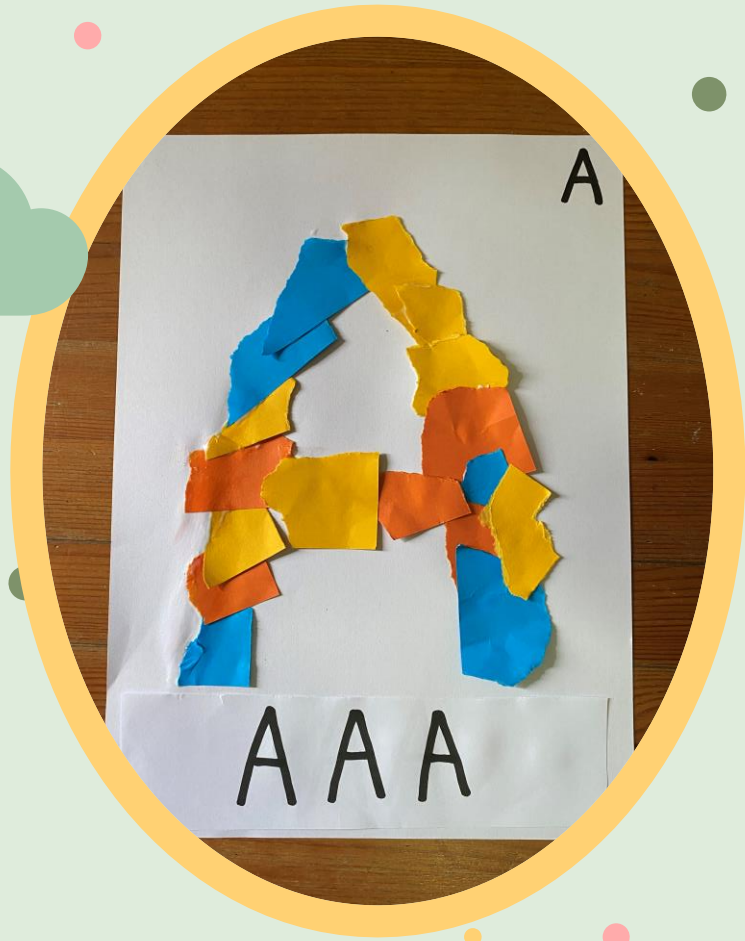
Step 4
