3. Scissors Use scissors with supervision or use a pair of child-size scissors




PREPARING SHAPES CUT-OUTS

Let's assemble your shapes!



Apply glue at the back of cut-out shapes

Paste the shapes on a coloured background Embellish with small strips of paper or triangles You can make a "road" with a long black strip of paper and small white rectangles



The last step...

Decorate your "flats" by drawing windows, lines or squares with your coloured markers 😂
