5. Early Dismissal of All Students

On Thursday, 26 October to Tuesday, 31 October 2023, **all students** will be dismissed at 12.45 p.m. to allow students to have adequate rest and recovery for the next day's exam and facilitate the marking of the Primary 3 to Primary 5 End-of-Year Written Examinations.

6. Primary 6 Post-PSLE Programme 2023

A spread of activities catered for the mind and body have been planned for our Primary 6 students as part of the post-PSLE Programme to continue to maximise their learning opportunities in Horizon Primary School. For example, the students will be embarking on their final series of lessons in Computational Thinking in Mathematics (CTIM). This is our Applied Learning Programme (ALP) which provides opportunities for students to acquire information and technology literacies as well as develop students' 21st century skills and dispositions such as resilience and collaboration.

Moreover, a half-day workshop has been arranged for all students to address the challenges associated with stress and anxiety, especially in the context of transitioning to secondary school and managing the inevitable changes that accompany their teenage years.

In addition, students will be involved the Conversational Chinese and Malay (CCM) programme. Through the programme, students will not only acquire basic proficiency in either Mandarin or Malay, they will also be introduced to the respective traditional culture and norms of the communities through the fun and engaging cultural activities.





Anticipating an exciting final out-of-school learning adventure with their peers, students will embark on the "Race to Sustainability!" programme at the Gardens by the Bay. More details about this educational journey will be shared closer to the scheduled date.
